General Business

Minutes: The minutes of the September 8, 2016, General Meeting and Awards Social were approved.

Treasurer's Report: Linda Johnson, Treasurer, reported that we currently have an operating cash balance of \$4,061 in the bank plus another \$415 in the Hole-in-One fund, for a total bank balance of \$4,476. The 2016 Budget is posted on the bulletin board in the Ladies Locker Room. Based on the amount of dues we have collected thus far, it looks like we should be right on target to pay all of our budgeted expenses for the year. The EBLGA Website is up and running, and members are encouraged to view the site often for all materials relating to the Association.

Directories: The members thanked Connie Kalberg, Directory Chair, for her great work in producing the 2016 directory, which came in under budget due to being printed at UPS. The directories are available in the Pro Shop for members who have not yet received them.

Awards: Kathy Simmons, reporting in the absence of Tournament Chair Madeline Clegg, went through the major dates and events for this summer. The Member-Member will be June 27 and 28; the Swing Fore a Sister will be July 12; the Chautauqua will be August 1 and 2; the Eagle Bend Club Championship will be August 20 and 21; and the President's Cup will be August 30 and 31. She emphasized that the President's Cup will be stroke play this year, and there will be Senior and Super-Senior flights also. According to our Bylaws, "The President's Cup shall be open to members of EBLGA who have played on at least 4 Ladies Days during the current season which may include the Member-Member Tournament and the Chautauqua."

Gardens: Jayne McManus thanked Robin and Herb Grant for their work in making the 6th hole Gardens so beautiful. Jayne also thanked the volunteers who helped weed the beds last Tuesday evening.

Niners: Judy Meseroll announced there are currently 21 active nine-hole golfers on the Thursday league.

Rules Clinics: Carol Chase is working with Michael to organize 3 dates for rules clinics in June, July, and August. She welcomes specific rules that members would like to learn; members can email Carol directly with the topics. Once the clinics are organized, an email blast will be sent. After discussion on the EBLGA rule that the highest a golfer can take on a Tuesday is a 10, Jayne said we can reconsider this rule in the Bylaws.

Ringer Cards: Bert Herndon, Ringers chair, announced the card is \$5 and each Tuesday, members can update their personal cards if the score on a hole is lower than previously recorded. Osprey will not be counted this year in Ringer play.
